

Bi-partisan cooperation

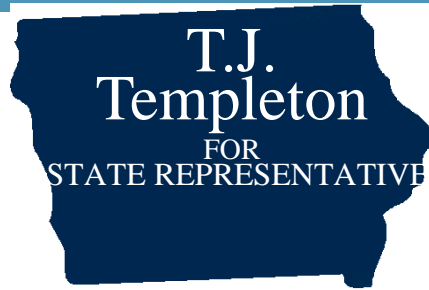
